Later on during the meeting, the discussion focused on the most important future goals of SCOG:

- 1. Establish membership approach all oncology facilities in Slovakia interested in participation in clinical trials.
- 2. Establish partnership with Slovakrin, Slovak Research Center and eventually other potential partners.
- 3. The following meeting was planned in 3 months during Bratislava Oncology Days. Members of the committee will have until then to think about priority projects to be handled within SCOG. The priority projects will be discussed at the next meeting.
